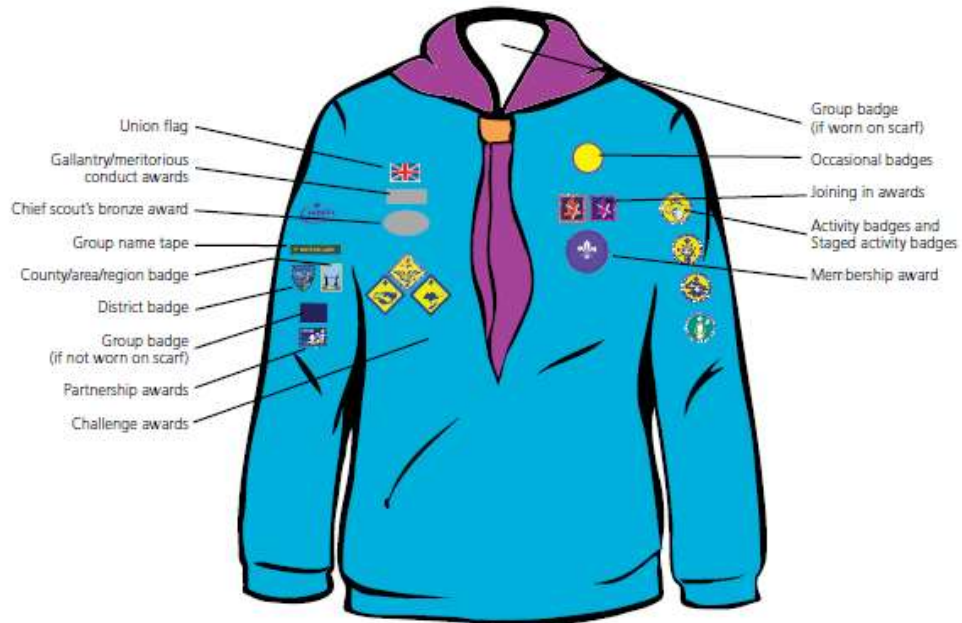
Uniform

Membership currently costs just £10 per month from when your child becomes a Member, making Beaver Scouts one of the most cost effective activities for children in our local area.

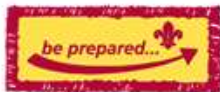
